Mogadore Reservoir is created by Mogadore Reservoir Dam on the Little Cuyahoga River in Portage County, Ohio and is used for recreation and drinking water purposes. Construction of Mogadore Reservoir Dam was completed in 1938. At normal levels it has a surface area of 2.2 square miles. It is property of City of Akron.

This is a set of three lakes. We will start out at the boat launch on the middle lake and make our way to the upper lake. This is a good fishing lake. Bring a lunch. There is a adult beverage stand next to the put in and a nice winery just a few miles up the road.

Directions:

Take Interstate 76 west toward Akron. Get off on exit 33. Go south on Sr. 43. The boat launch is on your left before the bridge.

OR

Take Sr. 224 west to Sr. 43 north and the boat launch is after the bridge.

OR

Take Sr. 5 west and Sr. 43 South The boat launch is on your left before the bridge.

Bread Pudding

one box of puff pastry (17 oz) baked according to package directions

1/2 Cup pistachio nuts Chopped

1/2 Cup silvered almonds toasted and Chopped
juice of one lemon

1/2 tsp lemon Zest. optional

(I like more lemon Zest)

1 1/2 cups milk

1/3 Cup sugar

pinch Cinnamon

2 eggs beaten

1 Cup light Cream

preheat oven to 375

butter a glass baking bowl then crumble cooked pastry into bowl. toss in nuts and lemon juice.

Heat milk, sugar, and Cinnamon to almost boiling. Add a little milk mixture to egg while stirring egg then add egg mixture to milk. Add lemon Zest then pour over pastry and mix lightly. Top with Cream. Bake for about 30 minutes until firm and golden. Serve hot, cold or room temp.
