The gently rolling hills, lush forests and sparkling waters disguise a land that has endured the effects of continental glaciers and massive mineral extraction.

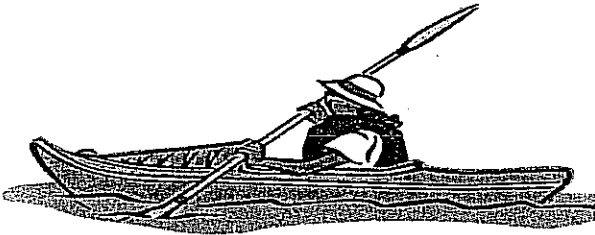
Each year over one million people visit the 16,725 acre park, yet never realize that many people helped restore the park from prior coal mining and oil and gas drilling practices. Today,
